Code of Conduct for Parents

- Encourage your child to play by the Laws of the Game.
- Do not place emphasis on winning at all costs and teach them to lose with dignity.
- Set a good example by applauding good play at every opportunity - both sides.
- Never ridicule, humiliate or shout at any young player for making a mistake or losing a match.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from the game.
- As a spectator, do not use profane language or harass referees, coaches or players.
- Do not publicly question the referees' judgement or honesty.
- Recognise the value and importance of volunteer referees and coaches. Be prepared to assist in the running of the club whenever appropriate. Get involved as much as possible.
- Encourage in your child an appreciation and mutual respect for team-mates and opponents.
